Round Rotherham Race and Relay Saturday 16 October

These are again on the same day as the National 6 & 4-stage road relays (and the Young Athletes relays are the following day) Entries for the race are building nicely. The **Round-Rotherham relay** is a particular challenge since we normally are depleted by the National Road relays.

The relay stages are from 11 miles down to about 4. Eight runners required (you can run twice but not on consecutive stages). It is not unknown for us to win the mens, women's and mixed relays but it doesn't just happen-

Track and Field Review

With all the league competitions approaching their final matches for this season, here is a review of where we are and what is coming up.

In the South Yorkshire T&F League, we are currently lying third behind Doncaster and Sheffield. After a promising opening match at Rotherham it has been left to a relatively small group of athletes across all ages to fly the Rotherham flag at the 'away' matches. We cannot catch Doncaster but a good turnout at the last match at **Doncaster on the 24th July** could at least get us into second ahead of Sheffield.

In the Young Athletes competition, the teams have tried hard but our lack of specialists to fill key technical events (hurdles, pole vault, high jump, hammer, triple jump) has made it a very difficult task to match the other clubs we have been up against. Our unexpected promotion to the Premier Division due to the league restructuring will be a short one. The final match is this **Sunday, 18th July in Middlesborough.**

In the Junior League, the same shortage of athletes in the specialist events has also affected result with us consistently finishing third. The final match is at **Doncaster on 25th July.**

In the Northern League, after winning the first match we came FIFTH in the second and then returned to winning ways in a very close home match in round 3. This leaves us in second place with the final match to come with both Lincoln and ourselves on 14 league points but they are above us with 1052 to our 1034 match points. We should qualify for the promotion match

but it is not certain yet. In the last match at **Scunthorpe on Saturday 31st July, Hull** would have to win and we would have to be last but the Rotherham match was close and our fifth place in the Hull match means we cannot get complacent and must have a good turnout at Scunthorpe. On a more positive note, **WHEN** we qualify for the playoffs the match will be at **Cudworth on August 15th.** If we want to get promotion and face better quality opposition then we need the best possible turnout at that match to make it happen.

Still with the seniors, we have just entered a team based on the performances from the first 3 league matches to see if we can qualify for the Inter Cup Knockout final and win some silverware. If we get through, the date for the final is **11th September at Trafford** and will incorporate the Northern 10000m championships.

Finally congratulations to all our Athletes who competed at the English Schools. Alex Kiwonya followed up last years win in the Junior Boys 100m with an impressive win in the Junior Boys 200m. Ben Shields was 5th in the final of the Inter Boys 100m, Kane Humphrey was 9th in the Senior Boys discus, Sarah Wilding was 8th in the Inter Girls shot, Abbie Vernon was 13th in the Senior Girls 1500m and Robyn Lanceley was 9th in the Senior Girls 1500m steeplechase.

Sundry Items

**Trail/fell series

We made a list of possible trail series races earlier this year, including some fell races. The intention being to possibly start a trail/fell championship series. This has stalled awaiting suggestions as to which are desired, unacceptable and so on.

**Herringthorpe

There is no development to report concerning the proposed stadium development other than what we already know. Which is, that the development is planned to go ahead over a period of between 3 and more years, depending on a number of factors such as financial climate, land sales etc. Recent and expected cutbacks will not help. Whatever we get to know, we will pass on.

**Clifton Park Time trial

The series ended in June. It is very likely that it will begin again in the autumn at least as a Rotherham HAC facility for training etc. The question of public involvement will have to be considered afresh. As you will be aware, the failure to deliver planned facilities for indoor organisation in the park rendered administration of the event(s) impossible in bad weather, and we subsequently ducked public involvement.
